



## Troopons® How-To

The overseas military commissaries have requested that Troopons be organized as discussed below.

Date: 12-1-2022

1. Clip out the coupons. Only "Manufacturer's Coupons" can be used. They can be from the newspaper, dispensers in grocery stores, tear-pads, and elsewhere but they must state "Manufacturer's Coupon" on them. No assistance vouchers, food stamps, store coupons, restaurant coupons, or internet coupons can be used and will be discarded.
2. Sort coupons into two piles by status:
  - Expired. Expired manufacturer coupons are still good for 6 months at U.S. military bases overseas! We just need time to get them there, and then the troops and their families still need time to consume them at their normal pace of life. So send only coupons that are not expired more than 2 months. (for example, if today were 1/1/2023, you would send coupon that expire 4/1/2023 or later)
  - Unexpired. At least 2 months of life left.
3. Sort each of those two piles into four piles by type:
  - Food
  - Non-food
  - Baby
  - Pet
4. Put each type in separate sandwich size baggies.
5. Mark the outside of each baggie to show whether the coupons are expired or unexpired, and whether they contain food, non-food, baby, or pet.
